WE CARE WARRANTY: **OPTIONAL \$10.00 per boarding stay.** For injury insurance while your dog stays at Countryside Kennel. (See attached warranty page 7)

GROUP PLAYTIME: This service is included when your dog stays at Countryside Kennel if your dog passes our temperament test. She/he will play with other dogs of similar temperament, size and play style. If your dog does not pass our temperament test, she/he will be outside twice each day in the play area by itself.

BATHING & GROOMING: By appointment. Reservation required. \$20.00 to \$80.00.

Check In Hours:

Guests can be checked in any time during business hours. You will be charged for boarding the day you check in, regardless of what time you check in.

Check Out Hours:

There is no charge for animals picked up before 11am Monday- Saturday.

All animals picked up after 11 am or on Sundays will be charged for that day.

Shot Requirements:

DOGS: DHLPP, RABIES AND BORDETELLA REQUIRED

CATS: FVRCP AND RABIES REQUIRED

Bordetella is required every 12 months. Some Veterinarians recommend every 6 months. Your dog's first Bordetella vaccine must be two weeks prior to its stay at the kennel.

**PROOF OF VACCINATION RECORD FROM VETERINARIAN IS REQUIRED.
PLEASE ATTACH BEHIND APPLICATION.**

Bring your dogs own food: We prefer that your dog remain on its current diet. Dietary changes can cause stress and stomach upset. Dog kibble should be brought in a plastic container. Storage is limited, please bring only enough for your dog's stay.

Bringing your dog's own bed or toys: We are happy to provide bedding. You are welcome to bring your dog's own bed and toys. All bedding and toys must be clearly labeled with permanent ink. We cannot accept bedding that is not easily washable, such as beanbags or pillows. **PLEASE NOTE:** We do not guarantee that we will return your bedding or toys to you. **Dogs often damage or destroy their bedding and toys when sleeping in an unfamiliar place.**

Fleas: We strive to keep Countryside Kennel a flea-free environment. If we find fleas on your dog when s/he comes to the kennel, we will give him a flea bath. The fee for a flea bath is \$35.00.

Changing your reservation: If you shorten your reservation, please be advised that we require 48 hours notice. If you do not provide us with the required notice, you will pay for the days you reserved. If you check out earlier than scheduled and provide us with 48 hours notice, a credit will gladly be applied to your account for a future kennel visit.

BOARDING CONTRACT

Countryside Kennel, hereinafter known as “the kennel” and the undersigned owner or person having custody of the following animal agrees as follows:

1. The undersigned requests the kennel board the pet(s) named _____ and agrees to pay for each day of boarding and for all agreed upon services in advance.
2. The kennel agrees to maintain clean and sanitary quarters, to provide food according to accepted standards, but does not guarantee immunity against communicable diseases beyond its control. Should such sickness develop, the kennel reserves the right to incur the cost of the veterinary service, the cost of which the undersigned agrees to reimburse the kennel, but the kennel is not to be held liable if it fails to secure veterinary care.
3. Upon failure of the undersigned to pay the board bill or fail to pick up pets as specified in this boarding contract, the kennel is hereby authorized to sell or otherwise dispose of said animal(s) in its absolute discretion per Civil Code #1834.5 (the abandoned animal act) which is clearly posted in the Kennel reception area and included on page 9.
4. All animals are boarded or trained, or otherwise cared for by workers of the kennel without liability on their part for loss or damage from disease, death, running away, theft, fire or injury to persons or pets, or property by said pets or other unavoidable causes, due diligence and care have been exercised.
5. The undersigned releases COUNTRYSIDE KENNEL, its owners, and employees, from all risk and damages, which may occur during my pets stay.
6. The provisions in this agreement apply to any future time the undersigned owner boards the same or other pets at the kennel. This agreement will be signed only once.
7. Animals showing infestation of fleas and ticks will be shampooed and treated at the owner’s expense of a maximum fee of \$35.00. We make every effort to maintain a flea-free environment, however we cannot be responsible for occasional occurrences of fleas.
8. Dog’s paws may become irritated by the pebbles when they play in the play yards. All efforts are made to prevent dog’s feet from becoming irritated, however, Countryside Kennel and its staff will in no way be held liable for any injuries to the dog’s paws or to any other body part.
9. Emergency Veterinary Care: Should my pet require emergency medical attention while being kenneled, I hereby agree that my pet will be treated at Pet Care Veterinary Hospital (on Fulton at Guerneville Road.) I will be responsible for reimbursing Countryside Kennel for any and all veterinary expenses incurred. I agree to reimburse Countryside Kennel when I pick up my pet.
10. Canine Cough can be contracted any time your dog comes into contact with another dog. All dogs boarding at the kennel have a current Bordetella shot, but the Bordetella vaccine is like the human flu shot and does not immunize all dogs against all strains of Canine Cough. Countryside Kennel and its staff will in no way be held liable for any strain of Canine Cough my dog may contract while at the kennel.

If I am unable to pick up my animals for any reason, I agree to contact Countryside Kennel immediately and agree to pay all additional fees incurred.

Agreement to Hold Harmless, Waiver and Assumption of Risk

I want my dog(s) to receive exercise/ playtime with other dogs at Countryside Kennel. My dog is well socialized with other dogs. My dog will not attack or bite another dog.

I understand that this is not without risk to my dog, because some dogs may bite or injure each other while playing.

I understand that it might take a while for dogs to become accustomed to group play. Initially their feet may get sore until they become accustomed to playing on the gravel. Generally this soreness does not present a problem and goes away after the dog has spent a few days playing at the kennel.

I understand that my dog's feet might get sore if s/he runs or plays hard in the gravel play area. I understand that sometimes gravel gets caught in between dog's toes and that this can cause a dog to limp.

I hereby waive and release Countryside Kennel and its employees, from any and all liability of any nature, for any injury or damage which my dog may suffer, including specifically, but not without limitation to, any injury or damage resulting from the action of any dog and I expressly assume the risk of such damage or injury.

In consideration of and as inducement to the acceptance of my application for my dog's participation in group exercise/ play with other dogs at Countryside Kennel, I hereby agree to indemnify and hold harmless Countryside Kennel and its employees from any and all claims.

TRAINING FIELD WAIVER

I hereby waive and release Countryside Kennel and its employees, from any and all liability of any nature, for injury or damage which my dog may suffer while my dog is in the training field. This includes escaping from six-foot fences, or any other injury or damage that may result from playing or running in the training field or from escaping from or attempting to escape from the six-foot high fences. I expressly assume the risk of damage or injury that may occur due to any of the aforementioned in this paragraph.

COUNTRYSIDE KENNEL'S WE CARE WARRANTY

This warranty will pay for emergency medical care your pet may need while staying at the kennel. This applies to both Boarding and Doggie Daycare dogs.

THIS WARRANTY COVERS THE FOLLOWING TYPES OF EMERGENCY CARE:

1. Sore feet: If your dog gets sore feet and requires veterinary care, Countryside Kennel will reimburse you for one visit to your vet to have your dog's feet examined.
2. If your dog gets in a fight or is bitten by another dog or suffers any type of injury while playing in the play yards, Countryside Kennel will reimburse you for one visit to the vet to have your dog's injury examined.
3. We require that all dogs boarding and/ or participating in Doggie Daycare receive a Bordetella vaccine every 12 months, at least two weeks prior to their first stay at the kennel. Canine Cough can be contracted any time your dog comes into contact with another dog. The Bordetella vaccine is similar to the human flu shot. It does not immunize all dogs against all strains of Canine Cough. If your dog contracts Canine Cough while staying at Countryside Kennel, Countryside Kennel will reimburse you for one visit to your vet to have your dog examined and medicated.

VACCINATIONS

Dear Dog Owner-

For your dogs safety your dog must have proof of current Rabies, DHLPP and Bordetella shots prior to boarding at Countryside Kennel. This prevents disease from spreading.

PLEASE BE ADVISED THAT THE BORDETELLA VACCINE, WHETHER GIVEN SUBQUTANEOUSLY (BY SHOT) OR INTRANASALY, DOES NOT PREVENT ALL STRAINS OF COLDS OR FLUS. YOUR DOG CAN STILL GET KENNEL COUGH OR A FLU EVEN IF S(HE) HAS THE PREVENTATIVE. YOUR DOG CAN ALSO GET SICK FROM THE VACCINE ITSELF AS IT CONTAINS LIVE VIRUSES. IT IS BEST TO VACCINATE YOUR DOG ATLEAST TWO WEEKS PRIOR TO ITS STAY AT COUNTRYSIDE KENNEL TO MAKE SURE THAT YOUR DOG HAS DEVELOPED FULL IMMUNITY.

California Abandoned Animal Act

Senate Bill No. 1018... (Senator Walter W Stiern)

An act to amend Section 1834.5 of the Civil Code, relating to abandoned animals

Section 1. Section 1834.5 of the Civil Code is amended to read:

1834.5. Notwithstanding any other provision of the law, whenever any animal is delivered to any veterinarian, dog kennel, cat kennel, pet-grooming parlor, animal hospital, or any other animal care facility pursuant to any written or oral agreement entered into after the effective date of this section, and the owner of such animal does not pick up the animal within 14 calendar days after the animal was due to be picked up, the animal shall be deemed to be abandoned. The person into whose custody the animal was placed for care shall first try for a period of not less than 10 days to find a new owner for the animal, and, if unable to place the animal with a new owner, shall thereafter humanely destroy the animal so abandoned.

If an animal so abandoned was left with a veterinarian or with a facility which has a veterinarian, and a new owner cannot be found pursuant to this section, such veterinarian shall humanely destroy the animal.

There shall be a notice posted in a conspicuous place or in conspicuous type in a written receipt given, to warn such person depositing an animal at such animal care facilities of the provisions or this section.
